TRUST YOUR CARD WITH NO ONE!

Traditionally, criminals steal credit cards or use a lost or stolen one. Now, thieves can sell authentication information like ZIP codes along with stolen card numbers on the web, and they're becoming more clever about how they obtain that information.

Credit card scam calls, can involve scammers notifying you of "suspicious charges" on your account or acting as your utility company, pretending that you're behind on your bills. You should also be wary when you're on vacation — scammers can call your hotel phone pretending that there

was a problem with the hotel's computer system, asking you to provide your credit card information again. But scams aren't just restricted to phone calls. With the rise of EMV chip-enabled credit cards, scammers are now sending emails asking you to update your information before receiving your EMV Card. Providing your credit card details in any of these scenarios is all a scammer needs to commit credit card fraud. But they can also carry out scams without any effort on your part, unbeknownst to you. Wi-Fi hot spots are common these days, but beware: scammers can create a free Wi-Fi hot spot without a password if you connect

to one and access your credit card online, they can steal your login details and possibly your credit card information if you make a purchase. They can also counterfeit credit cards by obtaining your credit card information with a skimmer, which often go undetected by consumers. Once they have your personal info, fraudsters can do everything from calling your credit card company or bank posing as you and claiming the card was lost or stolen to filling out fraudulent credit card applications (a form of identity theft) and making purchases. There's also been a rise in card-not-present fraud. This is when fraudsters make purchases with your

name and card number, but not your actual card, like for example online ordering. When you have your credit card in your possession, you can be completely unaware of this.

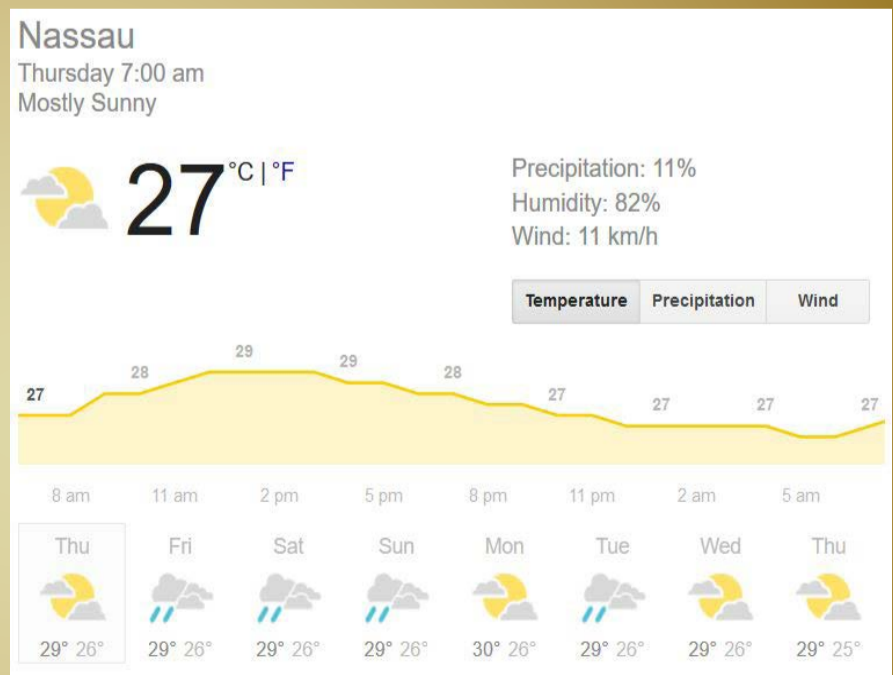

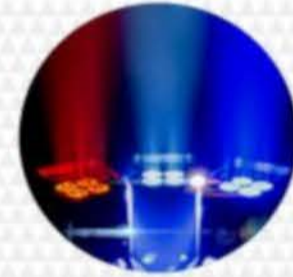

REDCROSS LINE IN NASSAU FULL OF HAITIAN CITIZENS WAITING FOR FREE GOODS

pleads and demands for the Bahamas to be softer ás related to the illegal immigrants the Bahamas itself must take a stand and March to the tune and rhythm set by itself and fight to maintain and preserve its sovereignty because other foreign individuals are fighting to take it over.

As you know, Morton Salt is the

largest private employer at Inagua and it was very essential for the government, workers and management that we reach this agreement for the sustainability of the economy of Inagua. As Minister of Labour, I am very pleased that this happened. During the negotiations the talks were very frank and at times very tense. As I always say, once we continue to talk we all can reach an agreement," said Minister Foulkes.

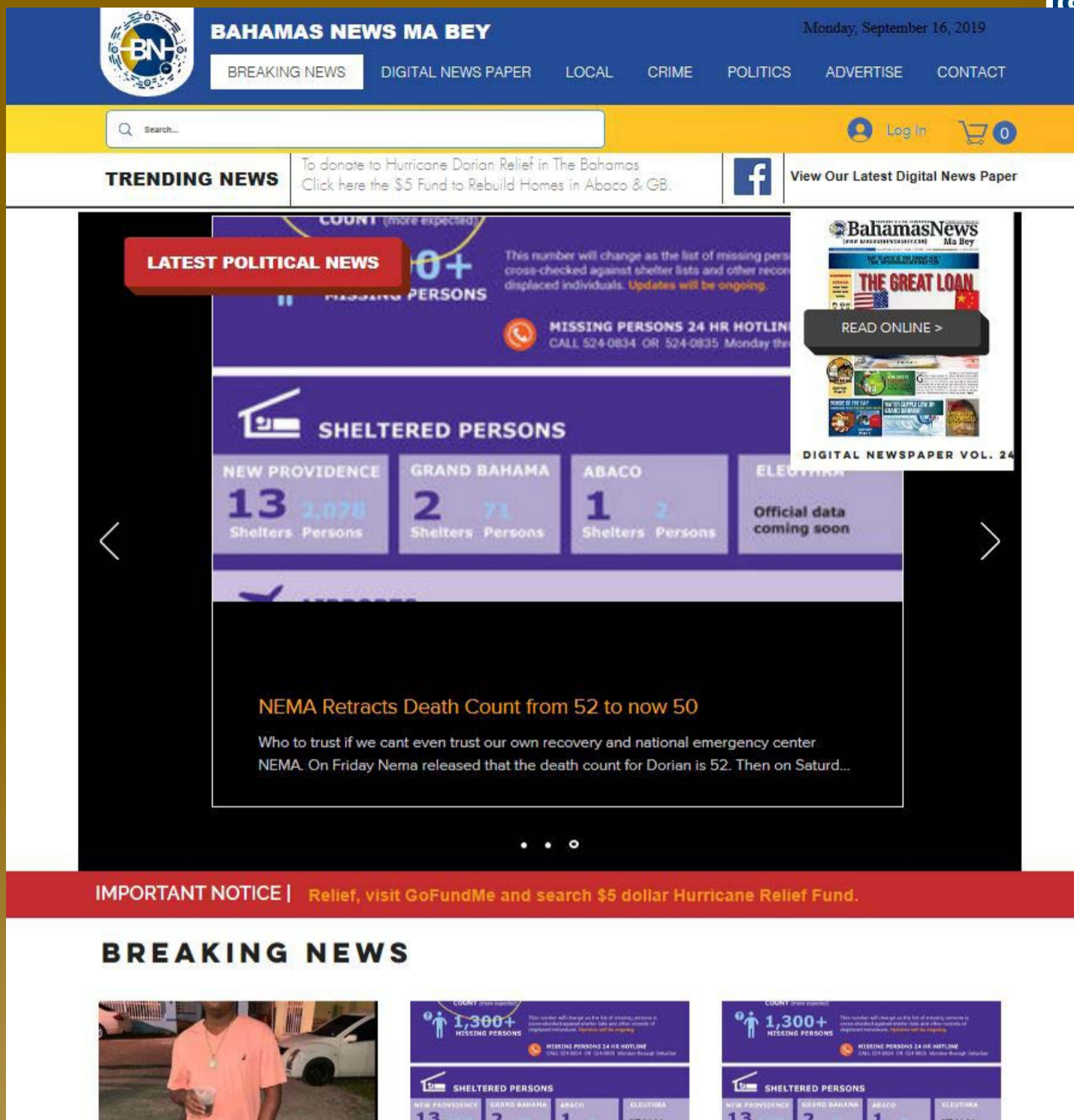
