


## THE PENNY ELIMINATION HOW COMPANIES WILL WIN

A penny is just a penny or is it? After all we throw them away almost immediately after we come out of the store or we leave them with the cashier for anyone coming behind who may be a few pennies short.

In a public correspondence released by the Central Bank of the Bahamas,

the Bank's proposal expected to come into effect December 2020 was announced. The proposal stated that the penny's creation and existence as being apart of the Bahamian currency will be eliminated as the lowest denomination. Furthermore stores will have to display and erect signage paid for and issued by the Central Bank in stores visibly that will explain the round off system

implemented. All items would round up or down to the nearest tenth. Items costing 1-2 cents will go down to zero case and point a 71- 72 cents item will become 70 cents and a 73-74 cent item will round off to 75 cents. Likewise a 76-77 cent item would become 75 cents and a 78-79 cent item would become an 80 cent item.

While No One wants to wrap or count pennies the reality is that merchants will be counting our pennies all the way to the bank. Rest assured soon "gone will be the

days," where items will have a 1 or 2 cents or a 6 or 7 cents at the end of their total cost and consumers can expect the instant penny or two increases on products in the very near future as merchants get ready to "kha-ching" their way to the bank.

The release stated that it costs more than the penny's value to produce the penny and rather than loose further on its creation the Bank proposes to eliminate its creation and part in our currency.



### Elimination of the 1-Cent Coin

#### Background

In 2018, the Central Bank of The Bahamas, with the assistance of Secura Monde International as consultants for the initiative, commissioned a study to examine the need for continued issuance of the 1-cent coin, taking into account the use of, demand for, and cost of producing and issuing the coin. As the sole issuer of banknotes and coins, the Central Bank is responsible for ensuring that these products function securely and efficiently, for both the cash management market and the general public.

#### Proposal

The proposal is that the 1-cent coin should cease to be legal tender with effect from December 31, 2020. If the 1-cent coin is eliminated, the 5-cent coin will be the lowest denomination issued. Electronic payments made, for instance, by debit and credit cards, will not be affected by this initiative. However, cash payments will be rounded off to the nearest 5 cents.

#### Rounding Rules

The proposed rounding rules are simple and fair for all. Where a total bill is being paid in cash and the number of cents to be paid does not end in zero or five, thus requiring either the customer to use 1-cent coins in payment or the retailer to use such coins in giving change, the amount of change to be paid will be rounded to the nearest 5 or 10 cents:

- 1 and 2 would be rounded down to zero (e.g. \$4.21 becomes \$4.20).
- 3 and 4 would be rounded up to 5 (e.g. \$7.23 becomes \$7.25).
- 6 and 7 would be rounded down to 5 (e.g. \$15.67 becomes \$15.65).
- 8 and 9 would be rounded up to 10 (e.g. \$27.89 becomes \$27.90).

It is important to note that rounding only takes place on the total bill, not on individual prices. As such, prices should not be changed in advance and existing price points (such as with items priced at 99 cents) should remain.

The amount of VAT (Value Added Tax) paid is unaffected by rounding. VAT is calculated on the amount charged for taxable supplies. Rounding should take place after the VAT is calculated on a bill and only when the customer is paying the total amount of an invoice in cash or paying the balance of an invoice in cash. If the customer is paying the total bill with cash and card, an amount rounded to the nearest 5 cents should be paid in cash and the remaining odd amount paid by card. For example, a total bill of \$23.39 could be paid with \$3.00 in cash and \$20.39 by card.


Another tropical storm has formed in the Atlantic and could strengthen into a hurricane by the end of the week.

### WHEN CURRENCY CHANGES OR GETS ELIMINATED

The Central Bank of Europe no longer produces 500 euro notes, and several European countries have established a maximum limit for making cash payments. In Italy and Portugal, for example, cash is accepted to pay up to 1,000 euros, after that you have to use cards, electronic payments or checks. Singapore also eliminated the largest denomination ticket a couple of years ago, and South Korea aims to eliminate the use of cash by 2020. The place where less cash is used today is Sweden, where only 1% of payments are made in cash, according to the BBC. In fact, in the Scandinavian country it is increasingly common to see notices that say "Cash is not accepted" at the entrance of shops and restaurants.

While setting aside money in cash can be useful for banks and governments, there are adverse effects for citizens. When all transactions are recorded, people lose privacy and the government gets a lot of information that could be used inappropriately. The recent scandal of Facebook and Cambridge Analytica for the misuse of user information has rekindled debates about the tension between the

use of technology and people's privacy. The difference is that anyone can leave Facebook if they believe their privacy is being compromised, but there is no such thing as getting out of the economy. Being left out is a different matter, but nobody wants to live without access to money. Some of those who could be left out of an economy without cash are the elderly and the poorest. In November 2016, the Prime Minister of India declared that the 500 (7 USD) and 1,000 rupee notes would stop circulating and would have no value at the beginning of 2017. At that time, 112 deaths were registered associated with the measures of demonetization. According to the Huffington Post, some cases were suicides, but most were elderly people who died long lines at the banks to change the bills before they left circulation. Governments around the world argue that the main

objective of reducing the use of cash is to fight against organized crime and terrorism. Being anonymous, cash transactions facilitate illegal money movements. However, it can be very optimistic to think that big illicit businesses like drug trafficking and human trafficking are going to disappear because they do not use bills. In the report "Cash, freedom, and crime", the German Bank notes that criminals can easily use alternative forms of payment, so eliminating cash has no major effect against illegality. As time passes more notes around the world will be destroyed, biggest and small, all of this will

be to fulfill the purpose of prompt information collection and data collection of every human being and their spending habits. STAY WOKE, you are always being watched people in every thing you do now a days.






